

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION FOR GRADES K-12

1. Up-to-date immunization record **signed by M.D. must include:**

DPT – 4 doses for children less than seven years of age, 4th dose must be given on or after the 4th birthday; any 5 doses are acceptable; 3 doses of DPT, DTap and Td to equal 3 doses for children seven years of age or older

TDAP– Born after 1/1/1997 and entering or attending grade 6 or transferring from an out-of-state or out-of-country school on or after September 1, 2008 shall have received one dose of Tdap on or after 10th birthday. If a Td was given less than 5 years before grade 6 then Tdap is due 5 years after that Td.

POLIO – 3 doses of Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) or (IPV)

For children less than 7 years of age; 3 doses with one dose preferable given after 4th birthday; or any 4 doses spaced by at least one month.

For children 7-17 years of age – any 3 doses.

Children 18 years or older are not required to begin or complete series.

MEASLES – If born on or after 1/1/90, 2 doses of measles-containing vaccine or one dose and lab evidence of immunity, preferably MMR (must be after 1st birthday and separated by at least one month)
If born before 1/1/90, 1 dose of measles-containing vaccine is required on or after the first birthday.

MUMPS – 1 dose, physician history or laboratory evidence of immunity
(must be after 1st birthday)

RUBELLA – 1 dose, physician history or laboratory evidence of immunity
(must be after 1st birthday)

VARICELLA (Chicken Pox) – one dose after 1st birthday for grades K & 1 or parental/physician evidence of disease or lab evidence of disease – children born after 1/1/98.

HEPATITIS B

Children born on or after 1/1/90 must have 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine, or provide laboratory evidence of immunity, prior to school entry into K-12.

Ages 11-15 only may receive the 2 dose Recombivox HB 1.0 ml by Merck or HEP B Adult Formulation 1.0 ml Merck.

MANTOUX – tuberculin skin test for students coming from certain countries (The four-pronged Tine Test is *not* acceptable.)

MENINGOCCAL – Born on or after January 1, 1997, entering or attending grade 6 or transferring from an out-of-state or out-of-country school on or after September 1, 2008, shall have received 1 dose of a meningoccal-containing vaccine.

2. Copy of birth certificate with official seal (not a hospital certificate)
3. Physical exam signed by M.D. 365 days or less prior to admission
4. Health History form (filled out by parents)
5. Dental visit 6 months or less prior to admission

***Records of the above requirements MUST BE COMPLETED AND APPROVED
by the school nurse no later than August 29th***

**NO STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL
WITHOUT SUBMITTING ITEMS 1-4.**

**These must be on file in the nurse's office in order to meet
NJ State requirements.**
